MAKING WAVES Q&A SESSIONS

Furthermore, this provides a platform for our young Caymanians to receive 121 mentoring with our specialist winners as ongoing support in their career development.

Participants had the opportunity to learn directly from award winners, gaining inspiration and practical advice on how to excel in their chosen fields. For those seeking further guidance, these sessions also offered a pathway to mentorship, enabling students to connect with Making Waves Award recipients who are eager to share their expertise and support the next generation of Caymanians.

By fostering these meaningful connections, Cayman Connection continues to empower students to dream bigger, aim higher, and realise their potential while strengthening ties within our global Caymanian community.

The Making Waves Awards celebrate the remarkable achievements of Caymanians abroad who exemplify resilience, innovation, and excellence. It is a privilege to honour these individuals who not only lead in their fields but also promote Cayman's culture and values on a global stage. Their stories inspire us all, highlighting the power of connection and the strength of our community.

Now in its third year, this initiative is spearheaded by Cayman Connection to celebrate the Cayman Islands, its culture, and its people.

Award winners were selected by a panel of five judges across eight award categories and celebrated at The Cayman Collections Centre in West Bay, along with a host of family and friends, as well as a congratulatory welcome delivered on behalf of Honourable Juliana O'Connor-Connolly, The Premier and Minister for Finance & Economic Development, Education, District Administration & Lands and Cabinet Office.

THE WINNERS OF THE 2024 MAKING WAVES AWARDS ARE:



MINISTRY OF YOUTH, SPORTS & HERITAGE SPORTS AWARD: CHARLOTTE WEBSTER

Charlotte qualified for the Olympic Games in sailing, representing the Cayman Islands at the Summer Olympics 2024 in Paris. She is one of the few young Caymanian women to achieve this feat in sailing. Her qualification was based on her exceptional performance at the PanAm Games in 2023, making her only the third Caymanian female to represent the islands in sailing at the Olympics.



MINISTRY OF HEALTH & WELLNESS HEALTH & WELLNESS AWARD: JANNET LAWRENCE

Jannet regularly opens her home and goes above and beyond to cater for vulnerable Caymanians who have to travel overseas to the US to access their required healthcare and for those in need during crisis periods.



ARTS, CULTURE & HERITAGE AWARD: JAZZ PITCAIRN

Jazz is a pioneering television and film writer, celebrated for her work highlighting Caymanian heritage. As the first Caymanian to write for an American network television show, she has broken barriers and paved the way for future artists. Her short film 'Ivan,' a poignant portrayal of a significant event in Caymanian history, has been selected for numerous Oscar-qualifying festivals and received critical acclaim. Jazz's storytelling prowess has garnered Emmy and NAACP nominations, making her a prominent figure in promoting Caymanian culture on an international stage.



DART EDUCATION AWARD: ANTONIO ARCH

Antonio is an outstanding scholar, published author, and lead of the Cayman Connection Book Club, bringing Caymanians together overseas to read and discuss diasporic and Caribbean culture. As a PhD researcher at the Department of Communications & Humanities at the University of Huddersfield in the UK, he has co-chaired two graduate research conferences and excels as a content specialist.



BULLISH STEM AWARD: KESSEAN MITTO

Kessean is the first and youngest Caymanian to pursue a PhD in Mathematical Science (Statistics). He has made significant contributions to education and public health forecasting, organised free tutoring for disadvantaged students, and served as a lecturer at UCCI. His work during the COVID-19 pandemic as part of the National Working Group for Forecasting COVID-19 Resources & Response, along with his active role in community service through the Rotaract Club, showcases his dedication to both academia and public health.



BULLISH STEM HIGHLY COMMENDED: SEBASTIAN CAHAJIA

At 14, Sebastian is an aspiring meteorologist who founded his own weather service and actively educates the community on severe weather preparedness. He has completed Skywarn certification and serves as a storm spotter and ambassador for the Weather Ready Nation.



MINISTRY OF SUSTAINABILITY & CLIMATE RESILIENCY ENVIRONMENT & SUSTAINABILITY AWARD: HAYLEY ROULSTONE

Hayley advocates for environmental policy reform and Indigenous inclusion. With a master's degree from the University of Sussex, she has worked on significant projects in Vancouver, Canada, promoting sustainable development and reconciliation. Her work contributes to many of the UN's Sustainable Development Goals, especially Reduced Inequality,

Sustainable Cities, and Peace and Justice.



MAPLES GROUP FINANCIAL, LEGAL & PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AWARD: RIDHIIMA KAPOOR

Ridhima, managing associate at Ogier in Dubai, specialises in structuring advice, fund formation, and digital asset funds.
