Primary duties include:

- Participating in research and data collection projects
- Assisting with public presentations, event coordination, and community engagement
- Supporting programme delivery in schools, public forums, and stakeholder meetings
- Collaborating with mentors and team members across multiple NDC initiatives

Eligibility Criteria:

- Students must have completed Year 12 or the equivalent (1st year A Levels, Dual Enrollment, CIFEC etc) or;
- Students must have completed A Levels, an associate's degree or equivalent and are taking a gap year or;
- Currently enrolled in a university programme or have completed their first year of university; or higher.

Relevant areas of study include: Must be currently enrolled in a university programme with a relevant area of study, including: Public Health, Psychology, Social Work, Health Education, Communications, Education, Sociology, Statistics, Data Science, Marketing, Graphic Design, Youth Work, and Political Science/Public Policy.
